With reference to the above, information collected from the O/C, Howrah PS on the points as sought for is sent hereunder: -

That on 23.04.12 a GDE was made at Howrah PS by one Debdas Roy of 41/1/A, Panchanantala Road, PS Howrah to the effect that an Electric connection would be given by CESC men at the premises of 41/1/A, Panchanantala Road, PS Howrah and there was a serious tension over that issue at that place. This refers to Howrah PS GDE. No.2373 dated 23.04.12. Accordingly Special RT officer S.I. S. Mallick was directed to look into the matter. Later information was also received from District Control Room that a dispute is going on over there. As such SI T. Aguan , SI U. Chatterjee and force also went there to attend the information. There was no written order in this regard.

If you are not satisfied with this reply, you can prefer an appeal to the Commissioner of Police, Howrah, the Appellate Authority of RTI Act. within 30 days from the date of receipt of this letter.



Proceedings: The petitioner Sri Soumen Das is present alongwith his lawyer Shri S. Mitra. The petitioner Sri Soumen Das submitted an RTI petition dated 28.04.2012 and reply was given to the petitioner vide this Office Memo No. 173/PG/RTI/CP (H) dt 30.05.2012 within the statutory period. The petitioner preferred an appeal vide letter dated 27.06.2012. The date of hearing appeal was fixed on 13.07.2012. The petitioner was absent that day. The petitioner again submitted an appeal dated 24.07.2012 for hearing and accordingly the hearing was fixed today i.e 14.07.2012.

As per RTI application, the petitioner wanted copy of any specific order based on which the police acted in the circumstances. The applicant questioned the logic of sending police to the place. This does not fall within the purview of the RTI Act. As per the act, only recorded information is to be supplied to the petitioner. It appears that the recorded information available has been supplied to the petitioner as mandated by the RTI Act. The reply given by the SPIO appears to be just and appropriate.

The applicant was informed that he can appeal to the Information Commission, West Bengal having office at Bhabani Bhaban, Alipore, Kolkata if he is not satisfied with the order.

The RTI appeal is disposed off.
